## NOTE

Calculation of the time difference in team events
The amount of time that a competitor must wait before starting is calculated by converting the number of points behind into time. Each point behind is equivalent to 1.333333 seconds of wait time. 45 points behind means a competitor starts one (1) minute later than the competitor in front of him.
Wave
To prevent too large start time differences, the Jury can decide upon the use of the "wave start". The competitors start in groups at ten (10) second intervals. At the end of the event their time differences calculated from the Ski Jumping competition are added to their finish time from the Cross-Country race.
