Possible Tie-breaker Games

Item: 1

Qualification for next Winter Universiade

Summary:

To decide the qualified/eliminated teams for the 2017 Winter Universiade, WCF rule C9 Team Ranking / Draw Shot Challenge (October 2014) will apply and one tie-breaker game may be played.

Details:

FISU's team selection procedure is as below:

If the number of entries is more than ten (10) the following criteria will be applied:

- a) the entry/ nomination and the payment of guarantee;
- b) those teams who finished in the top half of the previous Winter Universiade competition will be automatically qualified to participate; (example: 9 teams participated at the previous WU: 5 teams will be qualified to participate to the following WU if they fulfil the FISU entry procedure)
- c) teams finishing last in the previous Universiade involving up to nine (9) teams, and also the second last involving ten (10) teams, will not be selected.
- d) If one of the eliminated teams is from the host country of the upcoming tournament, then placed team before will be eliminated instead
- e) The remaining participating teams will be selected by a wild-card system according to criteria defined by the FISU CTI-UH (geography and continental representation, FISU ranking, WCF ranking).

This means that WCF rule C9 Team Ranking / Draw Shot Challenge (October 2014) will apply and one tie-breaker game may be played to decide the eliminated teams.
